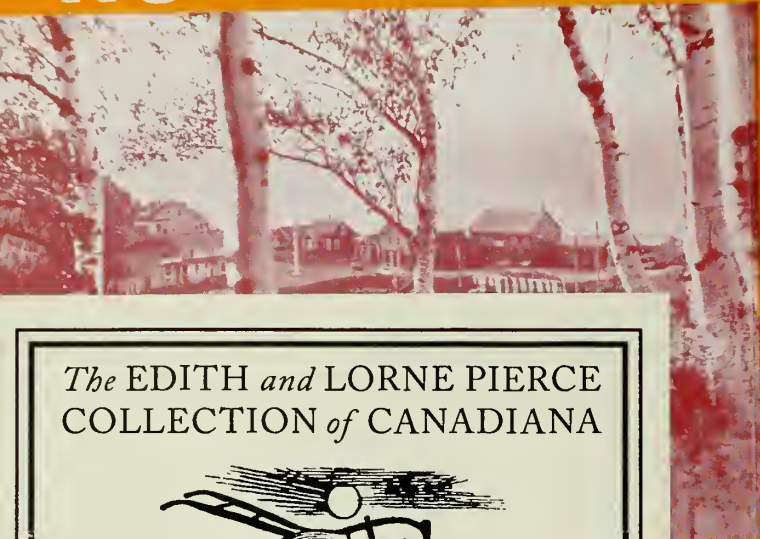

eye view of the harbor may be obtained . . . from the Citadel the party will visit the Public Gardens, regarded as one of the finest on the continent. The tour then proceeds to Dalhousie University, founded in 1821 . . . then to the North West Arm, center of aquatic sports for Eastern Canada, and visiting the Dingle and National Memorial Tower. Proceeding along beautiful country roads the tour visits Bedford and from there to Waverley . . . then further along the lovely countryside to Dartmouth. From Dartmouth the ferry is taken across the harbor to Halifax.

Tour No. 2

Halifax and Chester . . . automobiles leave from Ocean Terminals to the North West Arm, famous center of aquatic sports. Then proceeding through numerous picturesque villages such as Bowers, Hables, French Village, Hubbards, passing lakes and streams abundant with fish and through countryside famed for moose and deer to Chester, situated on a peninsula and popular seaside resort. For a magnificent blending of land and water it is unsurpassed. After stopping at Chester for a while the tour returns to Halifax and will then visit the interesting places there.

Tour No. 3

Halifax and Kentville . . . automobiles leave from Ocean Terminals, through the picturesque countryside to Bedford on Halifax Harbor and then to Windsor, the beginning of the famous fruit belt of Nova Scotia. From Windsor through the Annapolis Valley, famed Land of Evangeline, crossing the Avon River where can be observed the famous tides of the Bay of Fundy, to Hantsport. Then the tour proceeds to Grand Pré, where a stop is made to permit a visit to Evangeline Memorial Park. Grand Pré is the scene of Langfellow's famous poem "Evangeline". From Grand Pré the drive proceeds to Wolfville, center of a rich farming and fruit district, and then to Kentville which was settled in 1760. After one hour for an early dinner at Cornwallis Inn, the tour returns to Halifax.

Halifax, Waverley and Dartmouth . . . automobiles will leave from the Ocean Terminals and proceed to the entrance of Point Pleasant Park, consisting of 200 acres and containing many features of interest . . . automobiles are not permitted to enter the Park . . . then to Province House which was built in 1811 and is noted for its architecture, painting and memorials. The tour then proceeds to Citadel Hill from where a wonderful bird's
