PARISH of S^t. CHARLES Point du Lac

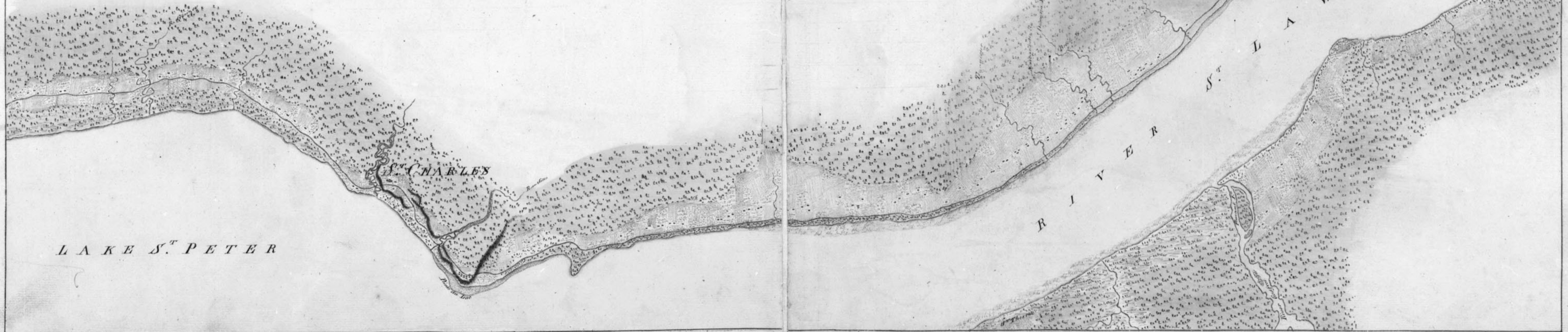
In a Bay of Mount Tanoucar which contains 16 Families and 30 Men able to Carry Arms In extent along the St. Lawrence is two leagues and a half and one in depth, this Parish being very low and Sandy is the reason of its not being better inhabited the King has always endeavored to get a number of Voyageurs to dwell upon the Point, but though he built houses there to receive them, never could get more than 12 Families to dwell in them, and they upon the taking of Quebec in 1709 not thinking themselves safe in the inhabited parts of the Country retired into the Woods and have not since been heard of, the King however leaves their houses standing in hopes of their coming back again

TOWN of the THREE RIVERS

The King or King of part of this Town and Parish, the Jesuit Monks hold and Govern of the rest, it is a small open place consisting of about 114 Families which contain 100 Men capable to carry Arms there are two communities in the Town, one of Recollets, and another of Ursulines, there is a very good large house built of Stone for the Governor, the greatest part of the other houses are of Wood and not very regularly built, there is an Iron Mine at S^t. Maurice which produces very good Iron, and is wrought in Forges which the French King intended to be built, and which if properly managed, would turn out to a very good Account
