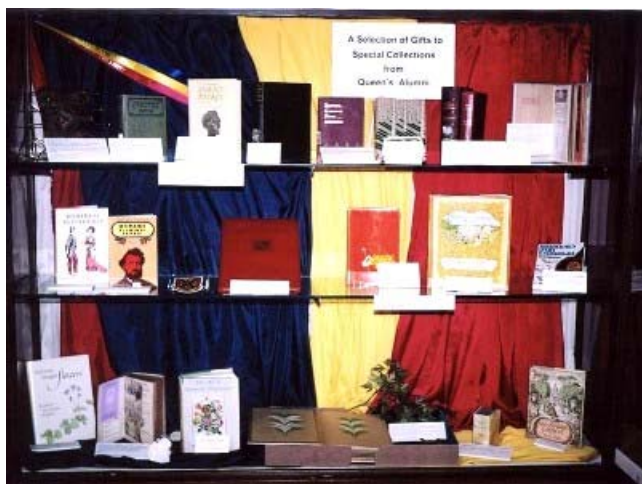
A Selection of Gifts to Special Collections from Queen's Alumni
